Mayor Tinker- I met up with Union Beach OEM yesterday and they have four trucks that they are concerned with. I am not sure which vehicles they are. I passed the phone off to Dave Rooke and he was talking to their OEM Coordinator and we made arrangements to bring one truck down to DPW this morning at 7AM. They do not know if they got salt water in the oil or whatever. I made the commitment that we would help them out as much as we could initially.

Committeeman Agre- With what four trucks that don't work?

Mayor Tinker- They are concerned about the salt water and what effects they have made on their trucks.

Committeeman Belasco- Last night I heard Tommy say he was ready to call in the other OEM Coordinators in the Bayshore area to try and see how they can help out.

Administrator Valentino- We will talk about that in a few minutes.

Mayor Tinker- They have four trucks and I would like to let them use First Vehicle and have them look at the trucks to see what they can do.

Committeeman Agre- What would they usually do?

Administrator Valentino- Their in town mechanic would look at it but that does not exist anymore.

Mayor Tinker- Does anyone have a problem with this?

Deputy Mayor Sachs – No I do not.

Committeeman Belasco – No I do not.

Deputy Mayor Sachs- Can they get the trucks over there?

Administrator Valentino- Yes. The damage is already done. This all happened in the first storm surge and they have just been running them since.

Mayor Tinker- The other thing we offer them was our mechanic for small tools. Things like chain saws, etc. to see if they need some maintenance to bring them over. It is not going to be swapping equipment out. If they can come over and they can fix it they will.

Administrator Valentino- If there are things you don't want them doing tell us that.

Committeeman Agre- Our stuff takes priority.

Committeeman Brady- Right.

Administrator Valentino- Luckily we did not lose one thing in this storm. The Union Beach Governing Body is meeting this morning at 10AM to have a similar meeting to the one you are having right now. There is a conversation of what level of commitment you want to make going forward to them. If I can suggest it is a matter of public safety and we are going to be discussing things about another town then I suggest we go into executive session.
