AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AMENDING SECTION 305-19 ONE WAY STREETS

WHEREAS, municipalities are empowered to make, amend, repeal, and enforce ordinances pursuant to N.J.S.A 40:48-1, et. seq.; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of Hazlet Township to amend Hazlet Township Code in order to eliminate the designation of Van Mater Terrace as a Through Street.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Hazlet, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, that Hazlet Township Code Section 305-20 Through Streets, shall be amended to eliminate the following:

PROVIDED THEREIN

WHEREAS, it is the desire of Hazlet Township to amend Hazlet Township Code in order to designate certain intersections as stop intersections:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Hazlet, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, that Hazlet Township Code Section 305-21 Stop Intersections, shall be amended to include the following:

Park Avenue and Van Mater Terrace	Van Mater Terrace (facing Westbound Traffic)
Delaware Avenue and Van Mater Terrace	Delaware Avenue

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Hazlet, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, that Hazlet Township Code Section 305-19 One-Way Streets, shall be amended to include the following:
