Statement made by Mayor David Tinker:

Citizens Hearing:

Charles Hoffman- Are there designated cooling centers for senior citizens?

Administrator Valentino- Emergency Operations Plan does have an allowance for emergency cooling centers depending upon the need and time of year. Most of the senior communities in the state are required to have emergency response plans of their own.

Committeeman Aagre- A few years ago when we had that power outage due to the heat wave North Centerville and West Keansburg Fire Companies were designated cooling places.

Charles Hoffman- When will our water be back in full swing?

Mayor Tinker- We never lost water.

Mr. Hoffman- They have asked us not to use it because we are supporting other people.

Administrator Valentino- Yesterday when the 18 of the 22 towns were returned we were told at that time Hazlet does not need to participate in any of the conference calls anymore because we are not affected. I don't know what the latest is.

Mr. Hoffman- Do the cooling centers show up on our website?

Administrator Valentino- No because we want to be able to designate.

Mr. Hoffman- Eighteen months ago or so when I was renewing something at the motor vehicle here in Hazlet, a lady walked up to the reception desk and was asked a question about her citizenship. She mistakenly said no I am not. You have a police officer there and the receptionist asked her if she was sure and I think the lady heard the question the wrong way. However, I asked the police officer if she would have taken any action if the person had in fact not been a citizen and she said no that is not our job. She said it was immigrations job.

Attorney Gorman- You do not need to be a citizen to get a driver's license that is a federal issue.

Mr. Hoffman- No it is not. The municipal law enforcement can enforce immigration laws.

Attorney Gorman- There are a number of states with laws pertaining to this but we do not have that in New Jersey.
