CAPITAL ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HAZLET, IN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, NEW JERSEY PROVIDING AN APPROPRIATION OF \$872,500 FOR VARIOUS ROAD IMPROVEMENTS, VARIOUS PARK IMPROVEMENTS AND PURCHASE OF MUNICIPAL VEHICLES, APPROPRIATING \$872,500 FROM THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND

BE IT ORDAINED, BY THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HAZLET, IN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, NEW JERSEY AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1:

The improvements described in Section 2 of this ordinance (the “Improvements”) are hereby authorized to be undertaken by the Township of Hazlet, New Jersey (the “Township”) as a general improvement. For the said Improvements there is hereby appropriated the amount of \$872,500, such sum includes the sum of \$872,500 from the Township’s Capital Improvement Fund.

SECTION 2:

(a) The Improvements authorized are as follows:

1. Reconstruction of various Township roadways and curbs, in the amount of \$750,000.
2. Improvements to various Township parks in the amount of \$62,500.
3. Purchase of 4x4 SUVs for Township personnel in the amount of \$60,000.

SECTION 3:

The capital budget of the Township is hereby amended (if required) to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith. The resolution in the form promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director, Division of Local Government Services, Department of Community Affairs, State of New Jersey is on file with the Township Clerk and is available for public inspection.

SECTION 4:

The following additional matters are hereby determined, declared, recited and stated:

(a) The Improvements described in Section 2 of this bond ordinance are not current expenses, and are capital improvements or properties that the Township may lawfully make or acquire as general improvements, and no part of the cost thereof has been or shall be specially assessed on property specially benefited thereby.

SECTION 5:

This ordinance shall take effect at the time and in the manner provided by law.

The capital budget of the Township is hereby amended (if required) to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith. The resolution in the form promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director, Division of Local Government Services, Department of Community Affairs, State of New Jersey is on file with the Township Clerk and is available for public inspection.

SECTION 4:

The following additional matters are hereby determined, declared, recited and stated:

ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HAZLET, COUNTY OF
MONMOUTH, AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AMENDING
AND SUPPLEMENTING THE TOWNSHIP CODE OF THE
TOWNSHIP OF HAZLET CHAPTER 11, ARTICLE V OPEN
SPACE ADVISORY COUNCIL

WHEREAS, municipalities are empowered to make, amend, repeal and enforce ordinances pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:48-1, et. seq.; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Township of Hazlet to amend the Hazlet Township Code in order to add an additional alternate to the membership of the Open Space Advisory Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Hazlet, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, that Chapter 11, Article V, §11-21A(6) of the Township Code shall and is hereby amended in order to provide for an additional alternate member of the Open Space Advisory Council for a total of two (2) alternate members to be designated as Alternate #1 and Alternate #2, respectively.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that Alternate #2 is hereby appointed and will have an initial term that will commence at the adoption of this ordinance and will expire on December 31, 2015. Thereafter, the appointment of Alternate #2 shall be for a two (2) year term to be staggered with the term of Alternate #1.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that:

- A. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
- B. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or a portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.
- C. This Ordinance shall become effective after second reading and publication as required by law.

ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HAZLET, COUNTY OF
MONMOUTH, AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AMENDING
AND SUPPLEMENTING THE TOWNSHIP CODE OF THE
TOWNSHIP OF HAZLET IN ORDER TO PROVIDE
CLASSIFICATIONS FOR APPLICANTS TO THE POLICE
DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, municipalities are empowered to make, amend, repeal and enforce ordinances pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:48-1, et. seq.; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:14-122.1 prohibits the Township from making residency within the Township a condition of employment for the purpose of original appointment, continued employment, promotion, or for any other purpose for any member of the Police Department; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:14-123.1a the Township may use residency as a factor when classifying eligible candidates for initial appointment; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee finds that it would be in the best interest of the Township of Hazlet to provide for such classifications as set forth in the aforesaid statute in order to have as many local residents as possible be in its Police Department which would promote a better standard of public safety.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Hazlet, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, that Chapter 104 of the Township Code entitled "Residency Requirements" shall be amended to add additional sections as follows:

Section 1. Classification of Applicants to Police Department.

Before any person shall be appointed as a member of the Police Department, the Chief of Police shall classify all the duly qualified applicants for the position or positions to be filled in the following classes:

Class I: residents of the Township of Hazlet.

Class II: residents of Monmouth County.

Class III: other residents of the State.

Class IV: all other qualified residents.

Within each such classification, duly qualified applicants who are veterans shall be accorded all such veterans preferences as are provided by law. Persons discharged from the service within six months prior to making application, who fulfill the requirements of N.J.S.A. 40A:14-123.1 and who thereby are entitled to appointment notwithstanding their failure to meet the New Jersey residency requirement at the time of their initial application, shall be placed in Class III. Preference in appointment second to that accorded to veterans pursuant to current law but superseding that accorded non-veterans shall be accorded all duly qualified applicants whose natural or adoptive parent was killed in the lawful discharge of official duties while serving as a law enforcement officer in any law enforcement agency in the State at any time prior to the closing date for the filing of an application, provided that required documentation is submitted with the application by the closing date. When a veteran and a non-veteran whose parent was killed in the lawful discharge of official duties while serving as a law enforcement officer in any law enforcement agency in the State are duly qualified applicants for a position, first preference shall be given to the veteran.

Section 2. Order of Appointments.

In making such appointments, the Chief of Police shall first appoint all those in Class I and then those in each succeeding class in the order above listed and shall appoint a person or persons in any such class only to a vacancy or vacancies remaining after all qualified applicants in the preceding class or classes have been appointed or have declined an offer of appointment.

Section 3. Certification of Eligibles for Positions.

The classes of qualified applicants defined in Section 1 above, shall be considered as separate and successive lists of eligibles, and the Civil Service Commission shall, when requested to certify eligibles for positions specified in this article, make such certifications from said classes separately and successively and shall certify no person from any such class until all persons in the preceding class or classes have been appointed or have declined offers of appointment.

Section 4. Applicability.

This article shall apply only to initial appointments and not to promotional appointments of persons already members of the Police Department.

Section 5. Temporary Appointments.


In making temporary appointments, the Chief of Police shall utilize the classifications set forth in Section 1 above, and shall classify accordingly all duly qualified applicants for the position or positions to be temporarily filled.

Section 6. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 7. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or a portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.

Section 8. This Ordinance shall become effective after second reading and publication as required by law.



RESOLUTION SUPPORTING A DETOUR OF HOLMDEL ROAD (CR 4)
IN THE TOWNSHIP OF HAZLET, NJ
FOR THE PURPOSE OF DECK REPAIRS TO THE BRIDGE
OVER THE GARDEN STATE PARKWAY

WHEREAS, Monmouth County Route 4 (CR 4) is a north-south transportation corridor serving regional travel needs between the Township of Colts Neck and the Township of Hazlet in Monmouth County; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of this project is to perform necessary maintenance repairs on the Holmdel Road (CR 4) bridges over the Garden State Parkway (GSP) located in the Township of Holmdel in the interest of public safety; and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Turnpike Authority (NJTA), the owner of the bridge, and its Contractor will undergo bridge deck panel replacements that will involve a local traffic detour having a duration that will exceed 48 hours; and

WHEREAS, based on comprehensive structural field evaluations, deck panel replacements are needed at NJTA Structure Nos. 116.7N/116.9S, Holmdel Road (CR 4) over the Garden State Parkway. The deck panels to be replaced are located in areas on the bridge that will not allow the safe passage of vehicular traffic during construction, thereby requiring a full traffic detour of Holmdel Road (CR 4) over the Garden State Parkway; and

WHEREAS, the detour at this location is expected to have a duration of approximately two weeks, and will be permitted between June 26, 2014 and August 27, 2014; and

WHEREAS, the detour will take traffic along northbound/southbound Holmdel Road (CR 4), and re-direct vehicles via Bethany Road, a local Municipal roadway within both Holmdel and Hazlet Townships, and Hillcrest Avenue, a local Municipal roadway within Holmdel Township; and

WHEREAS, this detour will not conflict with any other anticipated detours in the area, and the existing sidewalk and pedestrian accommodations along the north side of the bridge will remain open throughout construction; and

WHEREAS, the detour will provide guidance for detoured vehicles to access the Bayshore Community Hospital; and

WHEREAS, the NJTA's Contractor will be required to provide written notice to the Holmdel Township Engineer, Holmdel Township Police Department, Hazlet Township Engineer, Hazlet Township Police Department, Monmouth County Engineer, and Bayshore Community Hospital, a minimum of 14 days prior to the implementation of this detour; and

WHEREAS, during the design phase of this project, coordination and outreach with County and Municipal officials, including the Bayshore Community Hospital, was conducted regarding the needed work and proposed detour; and

WHEREAS, the detour was approved by the governing local authorities, and there were no cited objections to the proposed work or detour at this location; and

WHEREAS, a Certification Report, providing a description and justification for the proposed bridge repair work and detour, was submitted to and approved by the New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) in accordance with N.J.A.C. 16:27-4(f); and

WHEREAS, the NJDOT is requesting County and Municipal resolutions of support for the proposed detour, which is necessary to obtain NJDOT Commissioner approval for the closure on a non-State highway for a duration greater than 48 hours in accordance with N.J.A.C. 16:27-4(f); and

WHEREAS, based on the pressing safety need to replace several bridge deck panels on the Holmdel Road (CR 4) structures over the Garden State Parkway, it is recommended that the County of Monmouth approve the conditions of the proposed detour.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mayor and Township Committee of the Township of Hazlet do hereby endorse and fully support the detour of Holmdel Road (CR 4) for the purpose of bridge repairs, as described above, in the interest of public safety.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Township Clerk forward a certified true copy of this Resolution to the County Engineer, the New Jersey Turnpike Authority, the New Jersey Department of Transportation, and the Mayor of the governing body of the Township of Holmdel.
