## **Citizens Hearing:**

Bill Shewan – I would like to pause and revisit 2014 and acknowledge the previous Mayor and Township Committee. The cleanup that was done on the roads in Natco Park on behalf of myself and HAQLA was an excellent job. I believe the cost was deferred because we used our own people. I do hope the current administration continues on the project which according to DEP Regulations there were to be plantings along the road way where the items had been removed. Also, it appears to me that as a citizen the Public Works has expanded their responsibilities in doing certain things and I hope that continues. Such as the bridge over by the library. Also due to the fact that I make a lot of inquiries from time to time the openness was excellent over the last year with regard to my relationship as a citizen with the town itself through Dennis and different organizations and I hope it continues that way. It is all positive as far as I am concerned at this juncture and I look forward to another year in this town.

Liam Powers- President of HYAL and I want to personally thank Jim, Barbara and Dennis for doing a lot of work this past year. We have come a long way. Jimmy has been doing a lot of work with our football field and our organization and thank you for that. I have a question on how the process works for how Hazlet Recreation starts a new program. We recently just decided to switch our cheer program from Pop Warner to AYC in the interim doing that our cheer commissioner had quit the program and start a Pop Warner program. Her intention is to go to the township and start a program with Hazlet Recreation. We have a cheer program in town already and we shouldn't be fighting against each other for a program we already have in town. If you started a cheer program in town you would be starting from scratch with another league that is against ourselves. I just wanted to see what the process is to start a program like that in town with the recreation department?

Administrator Pino- I can tell you we did receive emails within the past week or so and Kathy brought it my attention yesterday about someone looking to start a new cheer program. She asked me if I had any thoughts and my first one is what happened to the old one? We found out that you are still doing cheer and there maybe a group of parents or person or individual who have a different opinion and want to go their own way. In that case it is not something that we would entertain because we are not interested in, again, doing something you are already doing. We have other things we can do. Like everything else our building are open to the public for use so if someone did ask to use them and they are available we do give out the building for use.

Mr. Powers- There are a lot of lies coming forward. We intend to grow our cheer program. I am about team unit and working together. Our E Board voted and we all want to move forward with AYC as a whole and this was fair enough. We do have a cheer program and we do not want to fight with the township over another cheer program in town. We are hoping to have your support in not starting another cheer program in town.

Administrator Pino- We do not have any plans and they did not bring it to anyones attention to start a new program.

Committeewoman Ronchetti- Liam was she looking to start a new program or just looking for a place to practice?

Mr. Powers – She is looking for a whole new program because she is on the Pop Warner Board and Shelly is on the Pop Warner and Coleen does not want to cut the apron string so she is looking to start a whole new program. We are AYC and she does not want to go to AYC at all. She is pure Pop Warner. They are similar programs and she has her own personal reasons for going in that direction. As the president of HYAL I owe it to our people to come down here and see how the process goes. We are here to look out for what is the best for the kids in Hazlet and the Board decided to go to AYC.

Mayor Sachs- First I am hearing of this and we have no interests.

Administrator Pino- It is not our business.
