Charles Hoffman - You are entering an agreement with Motor Vehicle and there will be a Hazlet Police officer present most of the time. My understanding is this was a function of Law Enforcement not necessarily security. My understanding is that is not the truth this is strictly a matter of security. The DMV system under covers scuff laws it is in the data base but my understanding is that if one of those people on one of those computers uncovers a scuff law who is applying that police officer cannot apprehend him.

Mayor Aagre- They would have to call the police department and have an officer on duty respond to the call. The police officer at Motor Vehicles is an Off-Duty police officer being paid directly by Motor Vehicle.

Attorney Gorman- If a crime happened there a police officer is going to jump in. If it is a paperwork type of crime that is not what he is there for. It is the policy of the DMV to have an Off-Duty police officer on duty.
