

**HOW TO IDENTIFY YOUR ZONE NUMBER  
AND USE THE SCHEDULE**

Remove the center sheet from this booklet. Locate your street from the list, which is in alphabetical order, and take notice of the coinciding zone number. On the sheet with the schedule, locate the schedule that matches your zone number and follow the schedule for all your curbside collections for the entire year. Take note of the following:

**CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS**

Construction debris is the responsibility of the contractor and/or resident to dispose of. This includes lumber, paneling, plasterboard, roofing material, fencing, concrete, asphalt, brick, and similar items. The resident and/or contractor must make arrangements with their garbage contractor for the disposal of these items.

**GRASS CLIPPINGS**

Hazlet Township does not collect curbside or accept grass clippings at the Recycling Yard at any time during the year. We encourage you to “clip it and leave it” or contact your garbage company to make the proper arrangements.

**RECHARGEABLE AND AUTOMOBILE BATTERIES**

You may drop off your rechargeable batteries at our recycling facility, located on Leocadia Ct. during operating hours (check hours of operation on page #1). Hazlet Township **no longer accepts** household batteries. You may also place rechargeable and automobile batteries curbside during the scheduled white metal collection.

**USED MOTOR OIL AND ANTIFREEZE**

Hazlet Township **will not accept** used motor oil, antifreeze, or used oil filters at our Recycling Center. Those items can be taken to a full service station or the Monmouth County Reclamation Center. The telephone number for the Monmouth County Reclamation Center is: 732-683-8686 ext. 5210.

**WHITE METAL**

White metal consists of all items made of metal including large appliances. Any items containing Freon, such as air conditioners, refrigerators, and freezers require a \$25.00 check made payable to Hazlet Township. These items will be collected 4 times a year (see the recycling schedule for these dates) or they may be brought to the Recycling facility during regular operating hours (check hours of operation on page #1).
