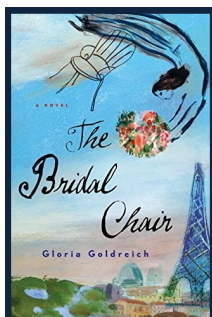
A delightful gem of a novel about family, forgiveness and finding your way from the bestselling author of *The Curious Charms of Arthur Pepper*.
