

HAZLET POLICE SPECIAL NEEDS REGISTRY



The **Hazlet Township Police Department** is working in partnership with Monmouth County to provide our residents with a Special Needs Registry. This registry was created to help police officers and other emergency service personnel better assist residents with special needs in the event of an emergency by providing those first responders with vital information regarding a registrant's special needs, emergency contact information, physical description and current photograph of the registrant..

The intent is to serve all members of Hazlet Township who may find their communication abilities challenged or ineffective when interacting with the police, and/or to help identify and find missing community members who pose an elopement or "wandering" risk. (Examples of registrants include, but are not limited to, individuals with developmental disabilities; individuals with Alzheimer's Disease or dementia; individuals with Autism, etc.)

Participation in the registry is completely **voluntary** and all information in the registry is **strictly confidential**.

All registrants will be issued window decals to be placed prominently on the front entrance of their residence as well as on their personal vehicle. The presence of the SNR decal should signify that someone in the residence/vehicle has some degree of special need and first responders should respond accordingly.
