Weather Advisory 1-2015

January 25, 2015

In anticipation of the developing weather conditions; we ask in advance for your attention, cooperation and assistance.

NO PARKING

We first remind all residents and business owners of the Township's ordinance: ***"whenever snow has fallen and the accumulation is such that it covers the streets or highways, an emergency shall be deemed to exist and no vehicle shall be parked on any of the streets or highways, or portions thereof, within the Township of Hazlet."***

Note: ***"The parking prohibition shall remain in effect after the snow has ceased and until the streets or highways have been plowed sufficiently and to the extent that parking will not interfere with snow plowing or the normal flow of traffic."***

Please remove all vehicles from the Township roadways when applicable and as described. Your cooperation will help us clear snow covered roadways more effectively and safer without parked vehicle obstructions.

OFF-STREET PARKING AVAILABLE

Additional off-street parking is available at the **Hazlet Swim & Tennis Club** for those with multiple vehicles needing off-street parking spaces.

SNOW REMOVAL

We remind you: ***“No person, nor the owner, tenant or occupant of any premises abutting on any street, shall throw, place or deposit any snow or ice into or upon any street in the Township, it being the intent and purpose of this provision to prohibit all persons from throwing, casting, placing or depositing snow and ice, which accumulated within the private property belonging to the person, upon the sidewalks or streets of the Township.”***
