## Weather Advisory 2-2015

January 26, 2015 – 10:00 AM

- Township ordinances for parking on snow covered roads are in full effect; we ask for your assistance and cooperation by removing all vehicles off the roadways immediately.
- **Hazlet Municipal Joint Court** sessions are cancelled for today; Monday 1/26/15 - 12:30-3:00 PM and Tuesday 1/27/15 - 5:00 PM.
- **Hazlet Recreation classes** at the Cullen Center are cancelled for tonight; Monday 1/26/15 and all classes for Tuesday 1/27/15 are also cancelled due to adverse weather conditions.
- All Recreation sponsored classes at any of the Hazlet schools for Monday January 26th are cancelled as the schools have scheduled an early dismissal. If schools close due to weather all programs are cancelled.
- Snow removal preparation continues and operations underway until further notice.

### **NO PARKING ON ROADWAYS**

The parking prohibition and Township ordinance is in full effect and will continue after the snow has stopped and roadways have been plowed sufficiently to the extent that parking will not interfere with snow removal operations.

If you have not already done so, please remove all vehicles from the Township roadways. Your cooperation will help us clear snow covered roadways more effectively and safer without obstructions.

### **OFF-STREET PARKING AVAILABLE**

Additional off-street parking is available at the **Hazlet Swim & Tennis Club** for those with multiple vehicles.

### **SNOW REMOVAL**

We remind you: *“No person, nor the owner, tenant or occupant of any premises abutting on any street, shall throw, place or deposit any snow or ice into or upon any street in the Township, it being the intent and purpose of this provision to prohibit all persons from throwing, casting, placing or depositing snow and ice, which accumulated within the private property belonging to the person, upon the sidewalks or streets of the Township.”*
