



Hazlet Township Weather Advisory 4-2015

January 26, 2015 – 10:30 PM

- **Travel ban** is in effect starting at 11:00 PM on 1/26/15. All vehicles except those specifically exempt are prohibited from operating on all roadways within the State.
- **Department of Public Works** snow removal operations are underway and will continue until further notice. Please note: plowed roads will become snow covered again as the storm continues and or need additional passes after their initial pass; please do not place snow or vehicles back into the roadways.
- **Flooding:** minor coastal flooding is possible with this storm and can occur at high tide in low lying areas within established flood zones.
- **State of Emergency** has been declared by Governor Christie. Municipal Offices in the Township are closed Tuesday 1/27/15.
- **Hazlet Municipal Joint Court** sessions are cancelled for Tuesday 1/27/15.
- **Hazlet Recreation classes** at the Cullen Center and other locations are cancelled for Tuesday 1/27/15.

NO PARKING ON ROADWAYS

The parking prohibition and Township ordinance is in full effect and will continue after the snow has stopped and roadways have been plowed sufficiently to the extent that parking will not interfere with snow removal operations.

If you have not already done so, please remove all vehicles from the Township roadways. Your cooperation will help us clear snow covered roadways more effectively and safer without obstructions.

OFF-STREET PARKING AVAILABLE

Additional off-street parking is available at the **Hazlet Swim & Tennis Club** for those with multiple vehicles.

SNOW REMOVAL

We remind you: *“No person, nor the owner, tenant or occupant of any premises abutting on any street, shall throw, place or deposit any snow or ice into or upon any street in the Township, it being the intent and purpose of this provision to prohibit all persons from throwing, casting, placing or depositing snow and ice, which accumulated within the private property belonging to the person, upon the sidewalks or streets of the Township.”*
