Weather Advisory 5-2015

January 27, 2015 – 10:30 AM

Thank you for your help and cooperation; reports indicate snow removal operations are very successful and efficient as a result of your assistance in preparation of the storm and its operations.

- **Travel ban** is lifted statewide; use extreme caution if you must travel today. It is recommended that you stay in place.
- **Hazardous driving conditions exist.** Icy roads are reported throughout the Township, County and State; Department of Public Works and others will continue to clear Township roadways over the next few days.
- **Flooding:** minor coastal flooding is still possible in low lying areas at times of high tide today in Raritan Bay - approximately 1:30 PM.
- **Fire Hydrants:** if possible, please assist our volunteer emergency responders by clearing snow away from the hydrants in your area.
- **Sidewalks:** for the safety of our residents and pedestrians please remove snow and ice from sidewalks on your property. Do not place or push removed snow into the roadway.
- **Street Parking:** plowed roads will become snow covered again as the snow and wind continues to drift possibly needing additional plowing; please keep all vehicles off the roadways until sufficiently cleared.
- **State of Emergency** has been declared by Governor Christie. Municipal Offices in the Township are closed today.

- **Hazlet Municipal Joint Court** sessions are cancelled for today, Tuesday 1/27/15.
- **Hazlet Recreation classes** at the Cullen Center and other locations are also cancelled for today, Tuesday 1/27/15.

NO PARKING ON ROADWAYS

The parking prohibition and Township ordinance is in full effect and will continue after the snow has stopped and roadways have been plowed sufficiently to the extent that parking will not interfere with snow removal operations.

If you have not already done so, please remove all vehicles from the Township roadways. Your cooperation will help us clear snow covered roadways more effectively and safer without obstructions.

SNOW REMOVAL

We remind you: ***“No person, nor the owner, tenant or occupant of any premises abutting on any street, shall throw, place or deposit any snow or ice into or upon any street in the Township, it being the intent and purpose of this provision to prohibit all persons from throwing, casting, placing or depositing snow and ice, which accumulated within the private property belonging to the person, upon the sidewalks or streets of the Township.”***
