County Recreation Grant Application

Robert Bengivenga- Municipal Administrator- We received a proposal for Little Libraries around town. There is nothing in our codes. We can get one and I’ll bring it to the committee.

Dennis Dayback- Township Engineer-We have two grants that are coming up, County Open Space, this year is \$500,000. matching grant. One of the requirements to the application is a public hearing.

Robert Bengivenga- Municipal Administrator- The hearing is scheduled for June 27th meeting. Application must submitted in by July 13th.

Dennis Dayback- Township Engineer- We are looking at the Dome.

Robert Bengivenga- Municipal Administrator- It will be where the hockey rink is. A multipurpose insulated Dome. We are also doing the salt dome in Leocadia.

Deputy Mayor Terranova- We do not have to figure things out now however it opens a lot of opportunities.

Committeeman Glackin- Is there a way we can break up the building where we get \$500,000.00 this year and do another \$500,000.00 next year. We put in a million and they put in a million in over two terms.

Dennis Dayback- Township Engineer- We have done that in Union Beach, Scholer Park, we did it in phases. We are on phase ten now. The county likes the approach and plans.

CDBG- Application Due July 23rd.

Dennis Dayback- Township Engineer- Two areas are eligible. CDBG is a grant by Monmouth County, they have grants up to \$200,000.00.

Deputy Mayor Terranova- \$200,000.00 per town or per street.

Dennis Dayback- Township Engineer- Per application. A public hearing is needed.

Robert Bengivenga- Municipal Administrator- Residences complaining about bamboo plants, as they are invasive.

James Gorman- Township Attorney- It can be banned however those who already have it, must upkeep, contain it. However, they cannot plant new ones.

Robert Bengivenga- Municipal Administrator- Regarding the LED flashing signs, they will be updated. Hazlet Fire district is interested in a few DPW vehicles. Is the Committee opposed to selling it to them as these vehicles were going up for auction? Resolution is needed.

Township Committee has approved sale to North Centerville Volunteer Fire Company.
